THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF DRYDEN

BY-LAW NUMBER 3781-2010

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND CHAPTER 259, WATERWORKS, OF THE MUNICIPAL CODE OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF DRYDEN TO INCREASE CERTAIN RATES IN THE CITY OF DRYDEN.

WHEREAS pursuant to section 391 of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, a municipality may pass by-laws imposing fees or charges on any class of persons, for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of it, for costs payable by it for services or activities provided or done by or on behalf of any other municipality or local board, and for the use of its property including property under its control; and,

WHEREAS The Council of The Corporation of The City of Dryden deems it necessary and expedient to amend Chapter 259, Waterworks of the Municipal Code of The Corporation of The City of Dryden to update certain rates in the City of Dryden.

NOW THEREFORE The Council of The Corporation of The City of Dryden enacts as follows:

1. THAT § 259-4. Monthly rate for waterworks services within city limits be deleted and replaced as follows:

§ 259-4. Monthly rate for waterworks services within city limits.

The monthly rate for waterworks services within the limits of the City of Dryden shall be as follows:

- T. Hospitals, Clinics, Schools:
Outlet rate shown in subsection (18) with Minimum: \$ 151.42/Mo.
- U. Industries: Metered rates as shown in subsection (24) with Minimum: \$ 121.61/Mo.
- V. Sprinkler systems: 4" diameter or less service line \$ 32.75/Mo.
Sprinkler systems: 6" diameter service line \$ 40.93/Mo.
- W. Water cooled refrigeration plants:
per rated horsepower or part thereof of the total horsepower of all motors or engines supplying power to water cooled compressors installed on the consumer premises. \$ 15.53/Mo.
- X. The rates for water through a metered supply shall be as follows (One City of Dryden Facility and One Industrial Site only):
First 25,000 gals or part thereof in any one month: \$ 121.61/Mo.
Next 200,000 gals in any one month: \$ 3.16/1,000 gals
Remaining gals in any one month: \$ 2.44/ 1,000 gals.
- Y. Where a Cafe or Restaurant is operated in conjunction with a Hotel or Motel and within the same buildings as that Hotel or Motel, no separate water rate for the Cafe or Restaurant shall be made, but the outlets in the Cafe or Restaurant shall be included in the amount of outlets for which the Hotel or Motel is charged.
- Z. Swimming Pools (City of Dryden Facility only):
Commercial - up to 120 square meters surface area: \$ 75.42
Commercial - over 120 square meters surface area: Metered Billing
- AA. Ready Mix Concrete Plants: \$ 595.14
- BB. Railway Stations: \$ 595.14

NOTE: Water rates for metered services apply only to the one (1) industrial and commercial swimming pool services as indicated. All other meters that may be installed are for monitoring purposes only.

2. THAT § 259-5. Monthly rate for waterworks services outside city limits be deleted and replaced as follows:

§ 259-5. Monthly rate for waterworks services outside city limits; reconnection charge.


- A. The monthly rate for waterworks services outside the limits of the City of Dryden shall be the same as the rates shown in §259-4 of this article except where the customer purchases water by bulk and provides his or her own transportation from the point of supply designated by Council, when the charge shall be:

- (1) Effective July 1, 2010: \$ 48.52 per 1,000 imperial gallons, with a minimum charge of \$ 20.22 per visit.

3. THAT this By-law shall come into force and take effect on July 1, 2010.
