Re: City of Dryden Draft Multi-Year Accessibility Plan

The City of Dryden is committed to meeting the needs of all those with whom we network in the conduct of our business and is committed to providing services and facilities in our community that are universally accessible to all.

Under the Accessibility for Ontarians with Disabilities Act, 2005 (A.O.D.A.) both public and private sector organizations are required to meet mandatory accessible standards. These are rules set by the Province that business and other organizations are required to follow in order to identify, remove and prevent barriers for people with disabilities.

In meeting its obligations under the Standards and to demonstrate its commitment to accessibility, the City of Dryden adopted an Accessibility Policy along with a draft Multi-Year Accessibility Plan for 2013-2017. The Policy along with the Plan will outline the City's strategy to prevent and remove barriers and meet its obligations under the Standards.

As part of its commitment to accessibility, the City is seeking input from the public and persons with disabilities prior to formally adopting the plan. To assist the public, a survey has been prepared to solicit feedback. Copies of the plan and survey are available on the City of Dryden website at www.dryden.ca. Also, hard copies of the survey and Plan are available at City Hall, the Library and the Dryden Pool and Fitness Centre.
