Sewage Treatment Plant components include a lift station, headwork's facility, sequencing batch reactor, equalization chamber, and UV disinfection unit, sludge holding tanks, dewatering facility, odor control system, mechanical, electrical, controls and associated works, as specified in the contract documents.
