AND FURTHER THAT the 2010 Municipal Elections are being conducted by Vote by Mail. Each qualified elector on the Voters' List will be receiving a complete "Voter's Kit" that will be mailed commencing September 27, 2010. The City of Dryden Ballot Return/Revision Centre will be open on Monday, October 4, 2010 between the hours of 9:00 a.m. and 4:30 p.m. up to Friday, October 22, 2010. **PLEASE NOTE ON VOTING DAY, MONDAY, OCTOBER 25, 2010, THE REVISION CENTRE WILL BE OPEN BETWEEN THE HOURS OF 10:00 A.M. AND 8:00 P.M. IN ACCORDANCE WITH LEGISLATION.** Electors may be added to the Voters' List and/or receive a blank Voter's Kit at City Hall in the event they did not receive one in the mail. Completed Return Voter Kits can be mailed or may also be deposited in the ballot "drop box" at City Hall.

A list of certified candidates and notice of acclamations has been posted on the City's website, City Hall, the Library and at the Recreation Office.
