## **PUBLIC NOTICE: RE: VACANCIES - APPOINTMENTS TO LOCAL BOARDS AND COMMITTEES**

An invitation is extended to the citizens of the City of Dryden to submit applications to serve on the following City of Dryden Boards/Committees. Appointments will be for the balance of the term of Council ending November 30, 2010 except as provided by statutory or other requirements.

### **DRYDEN MUSEUM ADVISORY BOARD (2 Vacancies)**

The role of appointees to the Dryden Museum Board is to make recommendations to the City of Dryden Council on the future development, policies, fees, rules and regulations relating to the Museum programs and facilities.

### **CITY OF DRYDEN CULTURAL ROUNDTABLE (3 Vacancies remaining)**

In June 2009, the Council of the City of Dryden adopted a Municipal Cultural Strategy for the City of Dryden. Included in the strategy was a commitment from City Council to establish a permanent Committee, referred to as the City of Dryden Cultural Roundtable. The Cultural Roundtable is responsible for acting as a catalyst to strengthen cultural development by supporting collaboration across community, business and municipal departments and interest groups. It will serve the community of Dryden by using the collective diversity and wisdom of its members to support the evolution of a Municipal Cultural Policy to fulfill the Municipal Cultural Strategy. The Committee will consist of 11 members including one (1) representative from Council and the Dryden Development Corporation, five (5) representatives from the public, and four (4) employees represented by the City and the Dryden Development Corporation.
