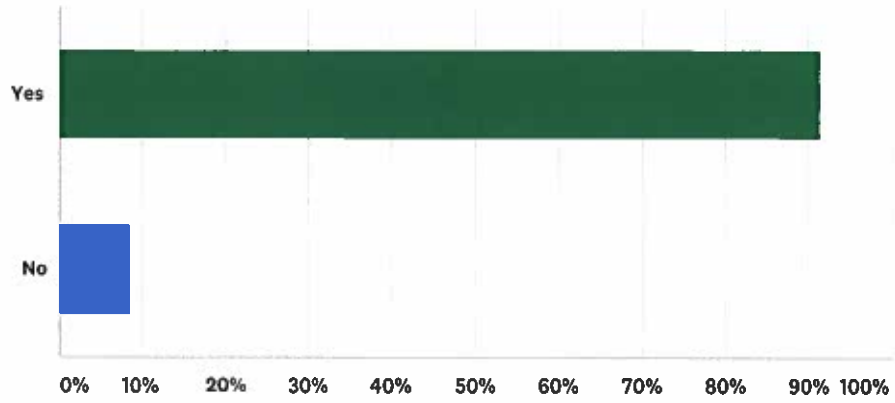

Answered: 471 Skipped: 3

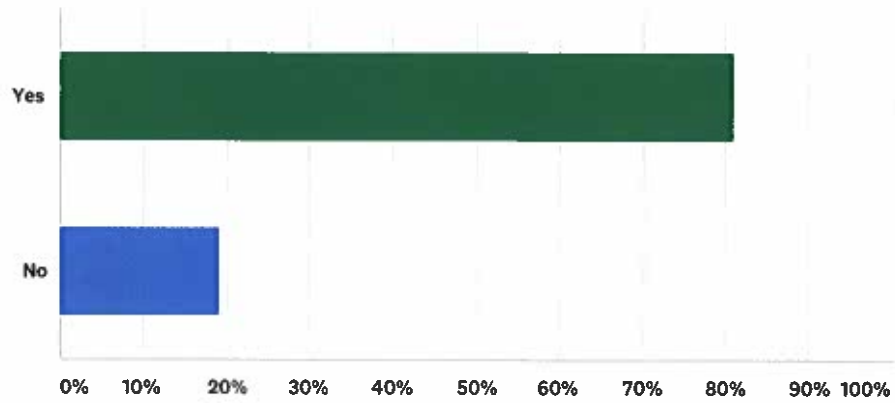

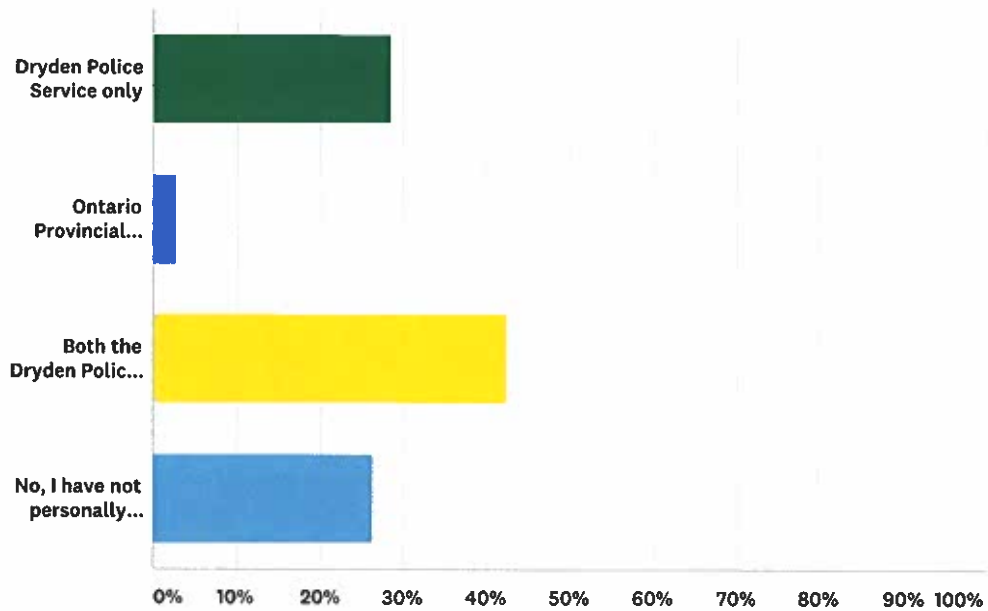

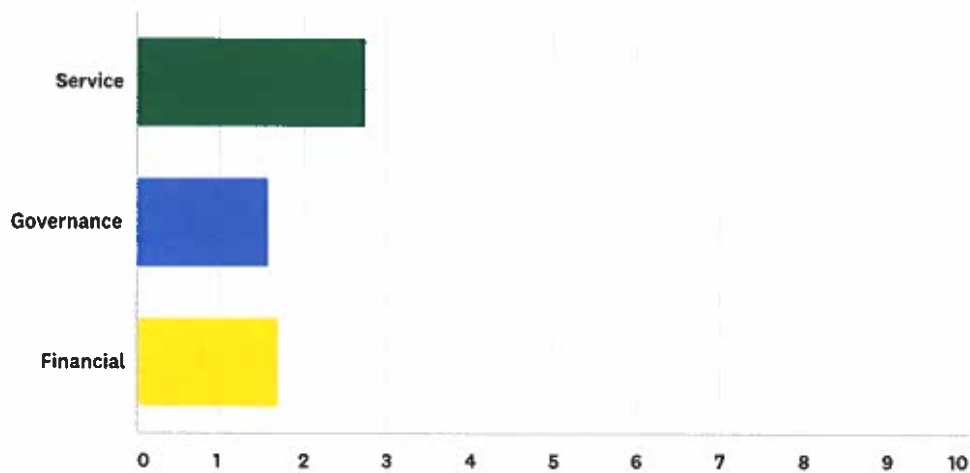

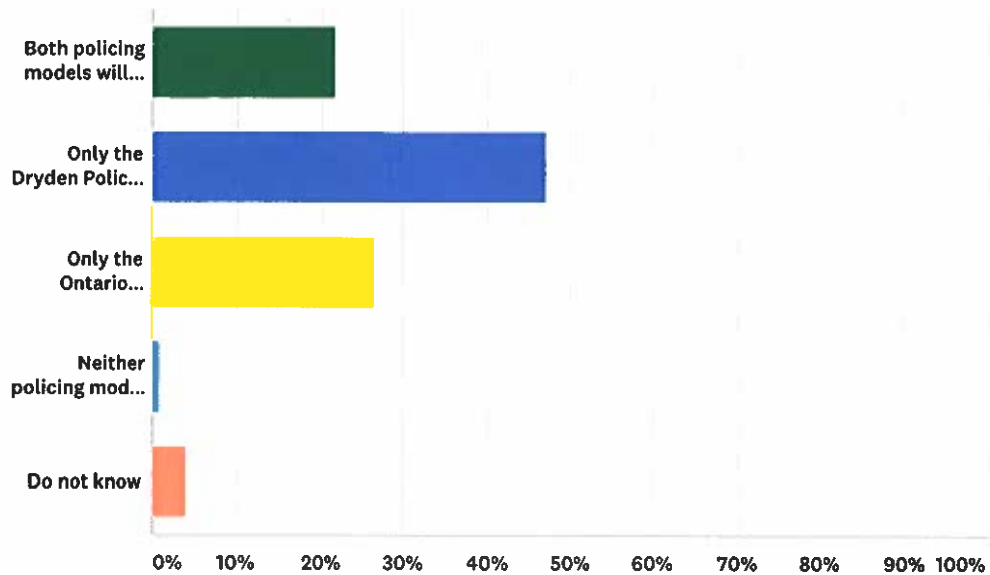

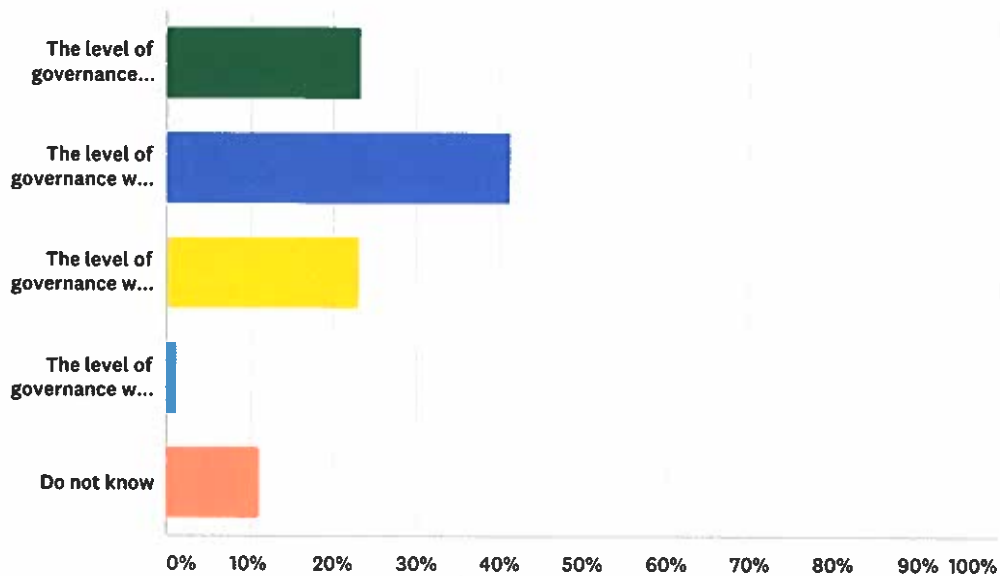

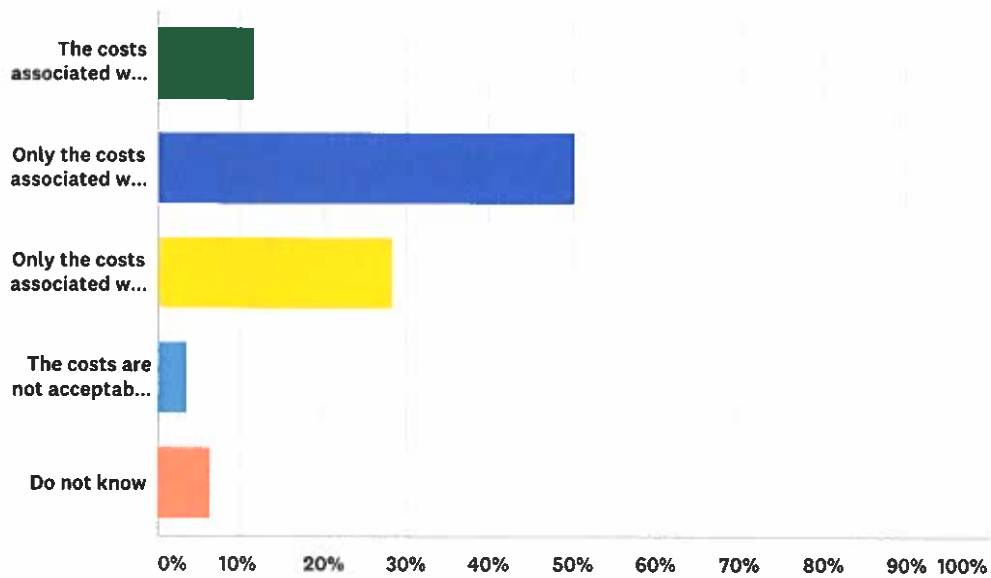

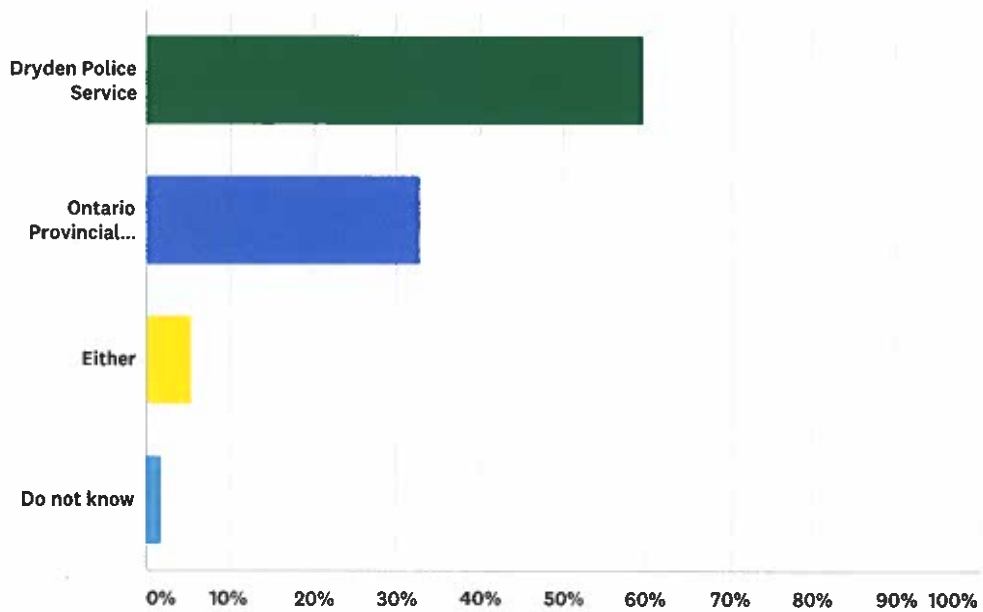
