The Ontario Research Fund (ORF) project is a large research grant that provides funding to produce collaborative research focused on the engineered barrier system being proposed by the NWMO for the long-term management of used nuclear fuel. This grant has created an inter-University network of faculty, staff and students from Western and York Universities, and the Universities of Waterloo and Toronto. Students from participating universities will host a poster session to present their research information.

The NWMO plans to select a site in 2024, and two areas remain in our site selection process: the Ignace area and South Bruce, both in Ontario.
