1.0 Policy Statement

1.1 The statement of values articulates the Board and staff's shared beliefs about important principles and norms by which the Library operates and delivers service. This policy articulates these values and outlines the review process.

- 2.2 The staff of the Library will reflect the statement of values in the delivery of day-to-day operations and services.
- 2.3 The statement of values is developed, reviewed and/or revised by the Board as part of the regular planning cycle.
- 2.4 The statement of values will be reviewed and/or revised as a precursor to strategic planning initiatives.
