

THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF DRYDEN

BY-LAW NUMBER 2026-9

BEING A BY-LAW TO AMEND BY-LAW NUMBER 2025-10, ZONING BY-LAW OF THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF DRYDEN.

WHEREAS authority is provided in accordance with Section 34 of the Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, as amended, to pass a By-law to amend By-law Number 2025-10. The Ontario Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, as amended, provides that the Council of a local municipality may, in a By-law passed under Section 34, authorize the use of land, buildings or structures for any purpose set out therein that is otherwise prohibited by the By-law; and

WHEREAS it is advisable and expedient to amend By-law Number 2025-10, Zoning By-law of the Corporation of the City of Dryden; and

WHEREAS Council has determined that no further public meeting is required.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Dryden enacts as follows:

1. THAT Schedule 1 of Zoning By-law 2025-10 be amended by rezoning the lands by applying a site-specific exception to the lands municipally known as 11 Casimir Avenue, legally described as PCL 15469, 14251, 14568 & 14567 SEC DKF; LTS 25 to 28, PL M153; City of Dryden.
2. THAT Section 4.13.3 of Zoning By-law 2025-10 be amended by adding the following site-specific exception:

CG-5 11 Casimir Avenue – In addition to the uses permitted in the General Commercial (CG) Zone, a Group Home shall be permitted.
3. THAT this By-law conforms to the Official Plan for the City of Dryden which was approved by the Ministry of Municipal Affairs and Housing on December 20, 2024.
4. THAT this By-law shall come into force and take effect upon the final passage hereof subject to the issuance of a certificate by the City Clerk pursuant to Section 34(22) of The Planning Act, R.S.O. 1990, c.P.13, as amended, and, where applicable, subject to the approval of the Ontario Land Tribunal.
