5. Agenda Items:

(a) <u>Costing Process from the Perspective of Other Chiefs – Chief Palson.</u>

Chief Palson attended the OACP Conference and other events this summer and was able to make several connections to gather information. Highlights include:

- > Shelbourne is deferred to January 2019. Looking at possible amalgamation with a neighbouring community.
- Midland still working through the process with pension issues.
- > OPP staffing shortages are occurring throughout the province.
- West Nipissing is currently in a battle between the Council and Board re processes. Board is taking to it to a judicial review. Other issue is the interim facility is inadequate while new facility is being built.
- ➤ Acting Chief in Espanola advised 6 months into process and transition on October 11, 2018 into Manitoulin Detachment area; both he and the Board Chair willing to talk to Dryden. OPP still not given offers of employment and not expected to get them until early October just prior to the transfer.
- Owen Sound survived the costing and decided not to move to OPP but did a service review to identify savings/efficiencies. The process took its toll on the organization and staff.
