Cadet Letkeman hired as Constable; currently at Ontario Police College; thus vacant Cadet position. Two additional constable vacancies (Stemkoski/Patterson). Three new recruits coming in October 2023 (one being Letkeman) plus one in February 2024; backfill for members joining Northern Deployment Program. Experienced Police Officer lateral transfer anticipated from Red Lake in October 2023.
Promotions:	Constable Thom Stemkoski and Erin Huckell were successful in Sergeant competition.
Recognition:	Recognition letter received for Constable Fedorchuk, Chevrier, Lockwood and Pearson for a traffic stop resulting in a significant (\$35,000) property seizure. Constable Parker was nominated for Coach Officer of the Year. Constable Bembeneck was nominated for 2023 International Association of Women Police (IAWP) Recognition Award Program. 


