## THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF DRYDEN

## **BY-LAW NUMBER 2025-65**

- BEING A BY-LAW TO AUTHORIZE THE APPOINTMENT OF A CLOSED MEETING INVESTIGATOR FOR THE CORPORATION OF THE CITY OF DRYDEN.
- WHEREAS Section 239.2 of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c.25, as amended, authorizes municipalities to appoint an investigator who has the function to investigate in an independent manner, on a complaint made to him or her by any person, whether the municipality or local board thereof has complied with Section 239 of the Act or its procedure by-law under Subsection 238 (2) in respect of a meeting or part of a meeting that was closed to the public, and to report on the investigation; and,
- WHEREAS subsection 9. of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that a municipality has the capacity, rights, and powers of a natural person for the purpose of exercising its authority under this or any other Act; and,
- WHEREAS subsection 5 (1) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, provides that the powers of a municipality shall be exercised by Council; and,
- WHEREAS subsection 5 (3) of the Municipal Act, S.O. 2001, c. 25, as amended, requires that all municipal powers, including natural person powers shall be exercised by by-law.

NOW THEREFORE the Council of The Corporation of The City of Dryden enacts as follows:

- 1. That Ontario Ombudsman shall be appointed as the Closed Meeting Investigator for the City of Dryden effective January 1, 2026.
- 2. That By-law 2022-51 shall be rescinded on January 1, 2026.
- 3. That this by-law shall come into force and take effect on January 1, 2026.
