Following discussion, the consensus was to recommend Council ask the OPP to aim for a presentation to them in November.

In the meantime, Chief Palson will be attending a Chief's meeting in June and will speak to some of his peers about the costing process their municipalities undertook in order to gain some insight into the process. As well, Mr. Lansdell-Roll was asked to calculate the cost of disbanding the DPS based on the disbandment language in the current collective agreement and on how it was handled in Midland using a variety of options.
